



Polycarbonate roof

When it comes to glazing your conservatory roof, polycarbonate is a popular choice as it is very strong, lightweight and durable. All the polycarbonate roof sheets we install are 35mm thick and are multi-chambered which helps retain the heat inside the conservatory. There are also various options when it comes to the colour of the polycarbonate sheets. Each colour will offer a different appearance and function as you will see below.



Clear

If the conservatory is North facing or in an area that is relatively shaded, it might be an idea to fit clear polycarbonate as it does offer excellent light transmission.

White in appearance, Opal polycarbonate would normally only be used on white upvc conservatories. As it offers good light transmission, it is ideal for locations that do not get a lot of direct sunlight. It also offers excellent privacy levels.





Bronze

Similar to clear polycarbonate but with a bronze tint. The tint helps to reduce glare and solar heat gain so it is perfect where a conservatory is situated in a location that gets a lot of direct sunlight.

Bronze on Opal

A combination of opal and bronze polycarbonate. The opal gives a bright internal appearance, even on a dull day whilst the bronze tint helps reduce glare and solar heat gain when it's sunny.





Solarguard

Grey in appearance from outside with opal internally. Solarguard limits the potential for heat build-up within the conservatory, whilst allowing light to enter the roof, deflecting solar radiation and reducing solar heat gain by up to 50%, when it's compared with conventional polycarbonates.



Glass roof

Installing glass instead of polycarbonate to your conservatory roof will offer a completely different aspect to the look and feel of your conservatory. Glass roofs are becoming more and more popular with the advances in high performance glass units available. Choosing a glass conservatory roof will considerably cut out the noise caused by the rain and can instantly give any conservatory the wow factor.

Selecting the right glass for your new conservatory roof is very important in order to avoid it becoming too hot in the summer or too cold in the winter. We install Conservaglass by market leading conservatory roof manufacturer Ultraframe. It comes in two different finishes and each offers a different appearance and function as you can see below.



CONSERVAGLASS

Conservaglass, launched by market leading conservatory roofing company Ultraframe, was the first high performance glazing product designed specifically for the requirements of conservatories in the UK climate.

In addition to keeping the sun's energy out in Summer and keeping the interior warm in Winter, it stays cleaner for longer than conventional glass. Not only does it stay cleaner for longer but a transparent coating bonded into the external surface of the glass (not sprayed onto the sealed unit after production like some competitor products) uses the power of ultra-violet rays and the rain to break down dirt and grime and wash it clean away. Of course this does not mean your glass will never require cleaning but it does reduce the amount of maintenance required and is much easier to clean than conventional glass.

Livin Room




If you are thinking of extending your home and can't decide between a conservatory or a traditional extension then the Livinroom may be the perfect answer. Firstly, it has the classic glazed conservatory roof at its heart and then adds an engineered framing system internally which is then fitted with plasterboard to give a perimeter ceiling all the way round. This creates something that is neither conservatory nor extension. It combines all the benefits of the former in terms of light and then fuses this with the solidity and feel of an extension. You can maintain light and space by using windows all round or have brick piers between windows and doors to give a greater sense of solidity.

Livin room by ultraframe



When it comes to the external look of the Livinroom there are additional styling upgrades available. The visual dynamics of the roof can be enhanced by upgrading to the decorative cornice all round the Livinroom for a smooth finish at the wall to roof interface. The cornice provides an elegant design feature whilst at the same it time hides the guttering that runs around the Livinroom.


